



All about sharks & rays


The oceans and our own western Indian ocean are home to many creatures among them sharks and rays.

Read on and we will take you on a journey to the ocean to see sommon sharks and rays.







My name is Silvy and I am a Silvertip reef shark. I can grow to 300cm long if I eat well!




I live on the reef and eat small fish, octopus and shellfish!

I'm Blacky and I am a Blacktip reef shark. I live in the reefs and eat small fish, octopus and shellfish.









I am Grey and I am a Grey reef shark

I am over 2 meters long and I live on coral reefs and along the coast




The local legend of the whale shark

I am called a white tip because the fin on top of my body has a white tip


> I am a cyrious shark and eat small fish, octopus and squid

I live on coral reefs and along the coast


Hey, I am Leo and I am a Leopard shark. I am also known as a zebra shark




I eqt fish, mollyscs qud shellfish
